

Guidelines for filling up of vacancies of Anganwadi Teachers (AWTs) and Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs)

Government accorded permission to fill up the vacancies of AWT and AWH in a phased manner. In the first phase AWT vacancies (in all areas) and AWH vacancies (only in Tribal areas) should be taken up.

(A) Selection committee:

District Level Selection Committee is constituted for appointment of Anganwadi Teachers and Anganwadi Helpers as follows (refer G.O.Ms.No.37, dt. 29.12.2022 Dept. for WCD&SC)

All ICDS Projects (except ITDA areas)

(B) Selection parameters

- For the post of Anganwadi Teacher and Anganwadi Helper, the Candidate shall be a local woman, resident of the ward in respect of urban area; resident of Grampanchayat in respect of rural area where the Anganwadi Centre is located.
- The post of Anganwadi Teacher and Anganwadi Helper earmarked for ST habitation as per SC/ST Sub plan, only ST candidate shall be eligible from the same hamlet/habitation.
- The post of Anganwadi Teacher and Anganwadi Helper earmarked for SC habitation as per SC/ST Sub plan, only SC candidate shall be eligible from the same Gram-panchayat.

(C) Weightage for selection

Government has informed the weightage for selection as follows (refer G.O.Ms.No.6, Dept. for WD, CW & DW Dt.30.03.2026)

(D) Educational qualification and Age:

- a) Intermediate / 12th Standard is the minimum educational qualification for the post of AWT and AWH.
- b) In case of Anganwadi Helper, if no candidate with Intermediate / 12th Standard education qualification is available, the candidate with next lower educational qualification (SSC) can be considered for selection (refer G.O.Ms.No.37, Dept. for WDCW, Dt. 29.12.2022).
- c) The candidate for the post of AWT & AWH shall be between 18-35 years age as per Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 guidelines.

(E) Reservations:

- a. The rule of reservation shall be implemented taking ICDS Project as the unit duly following the 100 point roster cycle prescribed in Rule-22 of Telangana State & Subordinate Service Rules, 1996. If there is insufficiency, the eligible reserved candidates when available in the village concerned will be selected. (Refer G.O. Ms.No. 7, Dept. for WCD&SC dt: 27.1.2012).
- b. In case of SC candidates [group-I, II & III], if eligible candidates for appointment to posts are not available to fill up the posts so reserved for the SCs in the roster point, they shall be filled with the candidates belonging to the next group of the Scheduled Castes as specified in section 3 of the Act in terms of orders issued in para-5 of G.O.Ms.10, SCD[POA.A2] Dept. Dated:14.04.2025.
- c. While considering disabled persons for selection of AWT/AWH, the instructions issued in Go.Ms.No.39, dated 06.09.2011 Dept. of WCD&SC shall be followed.
- d. The roster points shall be continued after the last roster point from previous recruitment notification.

In terms of Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 guidelines upto 50% posts of Anganwadi Teacher shall be filled by promotion of Anganwadi Helpers with 5 years of experience subject to availability of vacancies and fulfillment of educational qualifications, track record of service, additional qualification and age criteria. Remaining shall be filled up by notifications.

The entire selection process shall be taken up through online Software Application developed by the WD&CW Department for submission of applications by the individuals, generation of selection list, approval of the District Selection Committee and to issue appointment orders to the selected individuals.

Hence, all the DWOs are hereby instructed to follow the above guidelines and fill up the vacancies of Anganwadi Teachers (in all areas) and Anganwadi Helpers (only in Tribal areas) as per the procedure prescribed and duly following the GOs issued.

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ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, orders were issued constituting Committees for selection of Anganwadi Workers and Helpers.

2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, orders were issued prescribing certain guidelines regarding educational qualification, and age limit etc., for selection of Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers and also stated that only SC/STs candidates should be selected in Anganwadi centers / Mini Anganwadi centers earmarked for SCs/STs habitations respectively.

3. In the G.O. 4th read above, orders were issued relaxing age and qualification till the time that qualified local SC/ST candidates are available for SC/ST habitations in general areas and for posts reserved for SC/STs

4. In the reference 5th read above, the District Collector, Vizianagaram has stated that sufficient educated women from among SC's and ST's are available and that there is every need to consider their request for reservation, which will enable them to stand on their own and requested for implementation of rule of reservation in selection of Anganwadi Workers/Helpers in the Districts.

5. The officer on Special Duty, Andhra Pradesh State Commission for SCs& STs in the letter 6th read above while enclosing representation of AP Dalitha Cooli Rythu Sangam requesting implementation of Rule of Reservation, has requested the Government for suitable orders.

6. Government, taking into consideration the representations received, have decided to implement the rule of reservation in selection of AWWs/ AWHs in State. The rule of reservation shall be implemented taking ICDS Project as a unit duly following the instructions issued vide circular memo 3rd read above. In respect of rule of reservation for disabled, as the Anganwadi Workers are responsible for the safety and security of small children up-to age of 6, apart from providing nutrition and conducting pre-schooling for the overall development of the children, disabled candidates with minor disabilities be considered subject to the following:

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- Should be able to hear and communicate with the children and women with the help of Hearing Aid (for deaf);
- Orthopaedically disabled whose disability does not come in the way of her mobility such as to ensure protection of children and in conduct of pre- schooling;
- Visually challenged who can perform all their duties without assistants/escorts;

7. The District Collectors, who are chairmen of Selection Committees shall accordingly follow the Rule of reservation in selection of Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers & Mini Anganwadi Workers in the districts.

8. The Director, Women Development and Child Welfare, Hyderabad, A.P., is requested to take further necessary action in the matter.

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ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, orders were issued for implementation of rule of reservation in selection of Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers in state. The rule of reservation shall be implemented taking Integrated Child Development Scheme Project as a unit duly following the instructions issued vide reference 1st cited.

2. In continuation of G.O 1st read above, the following clarifications are issued for implementation of rule of reservation in selection of Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers:-

- 1) As SC/ST/BC candidates may not be available in all habitations the roster as prescribed cannot be followed. The Child Development Project Officers should therefore assess the sufficiency of candidates in a project. If there is insufficiency, the eligible reserved candidates when available in the village concerned will be selected.
- 2) If here are no reserved category candidates, available among eligible applicants, the vacant posts would be filled in future with such candidates as and when available, till sufficiency is reached.

3. All District Collectors, who are chairmen of Selection Committees are requested to follow the clarification accordingly in selection of Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers in the districts.

4. The Director, Women Development and Child Welfare, Hyderabad, A.P., is requested to take further necessary action in the matter.

3.2 Anganwadi Workers and Helpers: Qualification and Benefits under the Scheme

- i. The benefits of the Scheme will be provided to all the eligible beneficiaries through the platform of Anganwadi Centres by Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) and Anganwadi Helpers (AWHs) under the Scheme which considers the Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers as “honorary workers” from the local community who come forward to render their services on part-time basis in the area of child care and development. AWWs and AWHs are the grass root functionaries who shall implement the Scheme.
- ii. AWWs and AWHs being honorary workers shall be paid monthly honoraria as decided by Government from time to time.
- iii. Minimum prescribed qualification for AWW/AWH shall be 12th Standard and age limit shall be 18-35 years for engagement of AWWs and AWHs. Educational qualifications will apply to newly engaged AWW/AWH. The retirement age of Anganwadi Workers/Helpers shall be decided by the concerned State Government/UT Administration. In any case, AWW/AWH must not be engaged beyond the age of 65 years.
- iv. 50% posts of Anganwadi Worker shall be filled by promotion of Anganwadi Helpers with 5 years of experience subject to availability of vacancies and fulfilment of educational qualifications, track record of service, additional qualification and age criteria.
- v. 50% posts of Supervisors shall be filled by promotion of Anganwadi Workers with 5 years of experience subject to availability of vacancies having the prescribed educational qualifications as per the recruitment rules for the post of Supervisor failing which the vacancies shall be filled by direct recruitment.
- vi. Extant reservation orders on the subject issued by the Government in respect of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, etc. shall be kept in view by the State Governments/UT Administrations while promoting the AWW/AWH.

3. Government, after careful examination of the matter and in supersession of the orders issued in the reference 1st read above, hereby issue the following orders regarding selection procedure/parameters/nativity for appointment of Anganwadi Teachers, Mini Anganwadi Teachers and Anganwadi Helpers in the State:

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ORDER:

The following Notification shall be published in an Extra-ordinary issue of Telangana Gazette, Dated:14.04.2025:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Telangana Scheduled Castes (Rationalization of Reservations) Act, 2025 (Act No.15 of 2025), the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following Rules, namely:-

RULES

1. Short title and commencement: (1) These rules may be called as "the Telangana Scheduled Castes (Rationalization of Reservations) Rules, 2025".

(2) These Rules shall come into force from the date of publication in the Telangana Gazette.

2. Definitions: In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,

(a) 'Act' means the Telangana Scheduled Castes (Rationalization of Reservations) Act, 2025 (Act No.15 of 2025);

(b) 'Scheduled Castes' shall have the same meaning assigned to it in section 2(1)(f) of the Act;

3. Procedure for implementation of the rule of reservation: In order to implement the Rule of Reservation under section 3 of the Act,

(1) One percent of the posts in public appointments and seats for admissions into Educational Institutions out of 15% meant for Scheduled Castes, shall be reserved for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes-Group-I referred to in clause (a) of section 3 of the Act:

(P.T.O)

Provided that in the case of reservation of appointment to posts shall be allotted roster point at Sl.No.7 as specified in Rule 22(2)(e) of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996.

(2) Nine percent of the posts in public appointments and seats for admissions into Educational Institutions out of 15% meant for Scheduled Castes, shall be reserved for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes-Group-II referred to in clause (b) of section 3 of the Act:

Provided that in the case of reservation of appointment to posts shall be allotted roster points at Sl.Nos.2, 16, 27, 47, 52, 66, 72, 87, 97 as specified in Rule 22(2)(e) of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996.

(3) Five percent of the posts in public appointment to posts and for admissions into Educational Institutions out of 15% meant for Scheduled Castes, shall be reserved for the persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes-Group-III referred to in clause (c) of section 3 of the Act:

Provided that in the case of reservation of appointment to posts shall be allotted roster points at Sl.Nos.22, 41, 62, 77, 91 as specified in Rule 22(2)(e) of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996.

4. Reservation for Women: The reservation for Women to an extent of 33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % provided in public services and educational institutions shall be in accordance with existing rules in force.

5. Non availability of eligible candidates: (1) If eligible candidates for appointment to posts are not available to fill up the posts so reserved for the Scheduled Castes in the roster points as specified in Rule 3, they shall be filled up with the candidates belonging to the next group of the Scheduled Castes as specified in Section 3 of the Act.

(2) Similarly, if eligible candidates for admissions into Educational Institutions are not available to fill up the seats so reserved for the Scheduled Castes as specified in Rule 3, they shall be filled up with the candidates belonging to the next group of the Scheduled Castes as specified in Section 3 of the Act.

EXPLANATION: If any eligible candidates for appointment to posts and for admissions into Educational Institutions are not available from Scheduled Castes-Group-I, the same shall be filled with a candidate of Scheduled Castes-Group-II and so on and so forth.

6. Carry forward of vacancies: If no eligible Scheduled Caste candidates (including women candidate) belonging to any of the Scheduled Castes referred to in clauses (a), (b) and (c) of section 3 of the Act, are available, then the vacancy shall be carried forward as per the existing rules and shall not be filled up with a candidate belonging to any other community other than the Scheduled Castes in accordance with the rules or the instructions issued by the Government in this regard.

7. Non-applicability of the rules in public appointments/admissions:

(1) In the case of the notifications / advertisements, which have already been issued and not finalized for appointments in public service or admission into educational institutions, prior to the commencement of the Act, these rules shall not be made applicable.

(2) Similarly, in the cases any appointment to a post or service in any department of the Central Government or any Corporation or undertaking owned or controlled by it or to any Educational Institution belonging to or under the control of the Central Government or their entity, these rules shall not be made applicable.

8. Powers to remove doubts and difficulties: If any doubt or difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these rules, the Government may, by order, make such provisions or give such directions, not inconsistent with the provisions of this rule, as may appear to it to be necessary or expedient for the removal of the doubt or difficulty.
